Confirmation Pledge 2023

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The 'Pledge' is not in fact a part of the Sacrament or ceremony nevertheless, it has an important place, and the issue of the use and abuse of alcohol and the abuse of drugs is an important one for us all.

We propose to adopt a different approach to the pledge and to emphasize instead a commitment/pledge between the child/parent(s)/God. In doing so, we do not wish to downgrade its importance and value, in fact the very opposite is what we are attempting.

We are asking you and your son/daughter to discuss the subject and come to an agreement on what pledge might be appropriate for your situation. The following are some examples of different pledges:

Having discussed the pledge with my parents, I promise them, with the help of Almighty God, to: **A.** Abstain from all alcoholic drink until I am _____ years of age.

Or

B. Refrain from drinking alcoholic drink except in the company of one of my parents, until I am 18 years of age. **Or**

C. To inform them as soon as possible if I partake in alcoholic drink before I am 18 years of age.

I further promise that I will never use, or have anything to do with harmful drugs.

We ask you to discuss the various options with your daughter/son and to come to an understanding as to what pledge, if any, will be taken. It may be one of the above or indeed any variation of them that your child and yourselves decide on.

We ask that together with your son/daughter you say the attached pledge prayer and seal the pledge until the age you both have agreed upon.
